Gloucester represents 0.66 % of the \$88.439 billion in output generated in Hunter Region, 0.06 % of the \$1.003 trillion in output generated in New South Wales and 0.02 % of the \$3.294 trillion in output generated in Australia.

Definition: Output data represents the gross revenue generated by businesses/organisations in each of the industry sectors in a defined region. Gross revenue is also referred to as total sales or total income.
